Championships and Tournaments 2023 are currently being booked with Golf Courses. Dates and posters with full information for entry will be available as confirmations are made. Entry fees and catering costs continue to be challenging as demands for playing time have increased along with food costs. For 2023, Zone 3 and Zone 4 will combine for the <u>Amateur/Senior Championships</u>, <u>Junior Girls Tour Events</u>, <u>Women's Partner Best Ball</u>, and <u>Senior Women's Fall Classic</u>. This joint effort provides greater options for shotgun starts and course access.
