All Abilities Assessment Process



Players who wish to compete in the Canadian All Abilities Championship, presented by BDO must have an EDGA Access pass. All players should complete the EDGA Player Pass Application at: <u>EDGA Player Pass (edgagolf.com)</u>. Those who wish to obtain the WR4GD Pass must undergo the approval process. The process differs for those seeking approval in Intellectual Impairments and Physical Impairments and is outlined below.

A WR4GD Pass grants the player the opportunity to earn points on the World Ranking for Golfer's with Disabilities. Additionally, many international competitions require a player's approval on this ranking system and the pass number to compete.

Intellectual Impairments (II1, II2, II3)

The Canadian Athlete Association for Intellectual Impairments govern the submission and approval process within Canada. The CAAII submits all documentation to VIRTUS on behalf of the athletes. CAAII is the Canadian member organization of VIRTUS. Please note Sport Classifications is under the care of WPA. Process:

- 1. Athlete or family on behalf of an athlete contacts CAAII to receive the Virtus application and the Virtus guidance notes.
- 2. Two classifications are available:
 - a. National designation membership fee
 - b. International designation membership fee
- 3. Athlete must complete the Virtus Athlete Eligibility Application Form:
 - a. Form has to be completed in English.
 - b. Attach assessment reports and supporting medical evidence. Athletes must provide an assessment from a clinical psychologist within the last 5 years to accompany application.
 - c. Submit colored photo ID.
 - d. Copy of front page of passport
 - e. TSAL has to be completed by your coach.
 - f. Application has to be approved by Canada's National Eligibility Officer then the application is submitted to the Virtus International Eligibility Committee for their approval.
 - g. Successful applicants will be notified by CAAII and will receive an invoice from Virtus. CAAII will handle the payment process steps.
- 4. Submitted application processing time: 8-12 weeks to receive National or International designation.

Important Notes

- 1. Process can only be completed in English.
- 2. National and International designation must be paid in British pounds due to submission to VIRTUS.

On receipt of their Virtus Pass, players must apply for an EDGA Player Pass in order to be awarded a WR4GD Pass: <u>EDGA Player Pass (edgagolf.com)</u>

Physical Impairments:

Athletes seeking approval must have the following impairments:



- Impaired Muscle Power
- Impaired Passive Range of Movement
- Limb Deficiency
- Leg Length Difference
- Short Stature
- Hypertonia
- Ataxia
- Athetosis
- Vision Impairment

Athletes who have a physical impairment must be assessed by an EDGA Assessor to receive their WR4GD Pass, unless they have clear proof of limb length deficit or spinal cord injury in which case an EDGA WR4GD Pass can be awarded online by the EDGA Central Eligibility Team.
